

CALL FOR PROPOSALS – TSP

The Trainers of School Psychologist (TSP) invite submissions for poster presentations that can be categorized into one of the following areas:

- a. Research projects that focus on innovative ideas/practices pertaining to the preservice training of school psychologists

or

- b. Innovative program models or practices pertaining to the preservice training of school psychologists

or

- c. How university-based clinics are implemented and integrated into the preservice training of school psychologists

or

- d. International perspectives of school psychology (e.g., training issues, curriculum, international experiences included in pre-service training, etc.)

TSP continues to be committed to providing the most up-to-date and relevant services for its membership. As part of our Annual meeting held during the NASP conference, we will hold a Poster Session designed to meet the needs of trainers. Exact date /time/location during the Boston meeting in February, 2009 will be announced as soon as possible.

CALL FOR PROPOSALS – TSP

Submit all of the following information:

1. Abstract -200 words (maximum). The abstract of accepted presentations will be published in a Poster Session program that will be provided to all attendees.
2. Summary (no more than three double spaced pages) which includes:
 - Overview of the poster
 - Expected learning outcome for attendees
3. Cover page including:
 - Name(s) of presenter(s)
 - University affiliation
 - E-mail address of primary presenter
 - Phone number of primary presenter

Note: Only first presenter listed will be notified of acceptance. It is the responsibility of the first presenter to then notify all other presenters.

Due to the early date of the TSP/NASP conferences, review of proposals will begin immediately upon receipt. Those accepted for presentation will be notified by e-mail within one week of receipt. Proposals will undergo blind review for selection purposes. Any proposal received by **December 1, 2008 will receive full consideration. Any proposal received after December 1, 2008 will be considered on a “space available” basis only.**

Poster presenters should arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time. TSP will provide a 4' x 8' corkboard and push pins.

An expanded summary of each poster accepted will be published in a future edition of the TSP Forum.
